Introduction

Each international championship shall be held at most every two years. World Championships are held in uneven years. European Championships are held in even years. The organizers of the World and European Championships are the host country and the ITHF.

1. Choosing a location for the World and European Championships

1.1. Applicants for the right to host World or European Championships submit applications to the ITHF Executive Committee. The location of the World or European Championships is chosen by a vote of delegates at ITHF conferences.

1.2. When applying for a tournament, the organizers must announce the exact dates of the tournament, name of the city, phone numbers and contact details of the organizers and any other necessary information. If possible, they can indicate the exact venue of the tournament and directions to this venue.

2. Responsibilities of the organizers before the start of the tournament

2.1. At least 6 months before the start of the tournament, the organizers must create a web page containing all the information specified in paragraph 1.2. of these rules and they must submit a link to the ITHF. The organizers must provide a website with all information in English. Other languages are also allowed, but English must be the primary language.

2.2. The organizers must provide the participants of the tournament with the choice of accommodation near the venue of the competition. The championships can not be held in a place where it is not possible to accommodate all tournament participants.

2.3. The organizers must appoint a contact person, send out press releases and maintain close contact with the ITHF, national representatives, media regarding the tournament.

2.4. At least 1 month before the start of the tournament, the organizers must announce the names of the organizing committee of the tournament. The Organizing Committee must include at least one representative of the ITHF Executive Committee, who will supervise the entries of the teams and the scheduling of the competition.

2.5. At least 3 weeks before the start of the tournament, the organizers must announce the names of the Referee committee of the tournament. The head referee shall be one of the organizers who can answer all questions about the tournament and clarify and enforce all ITHF rules and guidelines. At least one member of the committee of referees must be fluent in the English language, but each member

should be able to understand English. It is recommended that each member of the committee of referees has a different nationality. The committee of referees must always have 5 members. As many ITHF Executive Committee (EC) members as possible must be selected as members of the committee of referees.

2.6. At least 2 weeks before the start of the tournament, the organizers should make all participants familiar with the audio timer that will be used at the tournament to count down the game time. If this audio timer does not meet the requirements specified in paragraph 4.4. of the Game Rules, at the request of the players not later than one week before the start of the tournament, the organizers must provide all participants with a new audio timer, which must fully comply with the above requirements. Before the start of the tournament directly at the venue, the organizers must once again familiarize the players with the audio timer that will be used at the tournament.

2.7. The organizers must prepare prizes for the champions and prize-winners of the championship. The top 3 finishers of the tournament in all individual categories must receive medals and cups (or special prizes). Cups or special prizes should be given to division winners in all categories. In the team competition, the top 3 teams must receive one cup per team and medals for each member of the team. The organizers may also determine any additional prizes and awards.

2.8. The tournament hall must meet the requirements specified in paragraph 3.2 of the Tournaments Rules.

2.9. Organizers should provide basic refreshment and comfort facilities during the tournament. There should be enough toilets for 120 people in the hall. The hall must have seating for the players to rest, drinking water and disposable tableware. There should be a food area or cafe next to the hall.

2.10. The organizers must provide online results and public video stream on the Internet, for example, YouTube.

2.11. The games to be used at the tournament must be new and comply with the requirements specified in paragraph 3.3 of the Tournaments Rules.

3. Responsibilities of the organizers during the tournament

3.1. The organizers are responsible for maintaining the official result sheets during the tournament, so that each player's results can be checked.

3.2. All games in the hall must be numbered, sides marked and score sheets must be understandable in English. The numbering order of the games is given in Appendix 1. There should also be pens next to the protocols.

3.3. The organizers should provide continuous reports of tournament results and standings. Participants should have a right to see their group standings at least once

during each group's schedule. The organizers can decide to stop continuous reports of tournament results and standings four rounds before the finish of the current group stage.

3.4. All announcements in the hall must be in English and can only be in the breaks between games.

3.5. The flags of all participating countries and a special banner with the symbols of the championship should be placed in the hall.

3.6. The organizers must ensure that all postponed matches are played as soon as possible. Transferring the game to the next round is not possible. Also, the organizers should monitor compliance with the timing and schedule.

3.7. The match schedule for each match must specify which side of which game each player shall use. The only exception is play-offs, where players can select games by themselves from the group of games that were chosen by the organizers for play-offs.

3.8. During play-offs, all players must have sufficient time to prepare themselves for their matches, and for finding the game where they want to play.

3.9. The organizers should ensure that all pairings in each play-off round begin their series at the same time.

3.10. The organizers must ensure that no participant will be bothered during the tournament by other players or by the audience. Players can ask for sufficient free space around them and around the table, especially during the play-off matches. The organizers must ensure that the audience will not disturb the players in any way, including loud talking or yelling.

3.11. The Game rules and game system shall be available in English.

3.12. In all official categories, the participation of players is free of charge. During the championship, the organizers can organize and collect fees for special tournaments. Also, the organizers can sell souvenirs, merch, food, drinks, etc. in the hall.

4. Rules for participants

4.1. At World Championships and European Championships, it must be clear which nation a player represents. All players shall play in their national team shirt. This could be a simple T-shirt with a symbol, flag or colors representing the nation.

4.2. Players may only represent countries for which they possess a valid travel (international) passport. If a player changes his country of residence, he can only

represent a new country at the World Championships and the European Championships if he changed the country in the World Ranking on or before December 31 of the previous year.

4.3. Only national federations can register players for these tournaments. All other players, who do not have their own national federation, must be approved for participation by the Executive Committee of the ITHF.

4.4. The World Championship is open for representatives of each country. Maximum numbers of representatives from each country are shown in the following table. Numbers of participants from organizing countries are stated in the brackets.

4.5 At the European Championship, only European citizens (i.e. holders of passports from Albania, Andorra, Armenia, Austria, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Belgium, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, the Faroe Islands, Finland, France, Georgia, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Israel, Italy, Kazakhstan, Kosovo, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, North Macedonia, Malta, Moldova, Monaco, Montenegro, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Russia, San Marino, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Turkey, Ukraine or the United Kingdom) can participate. Maximum numbers of participants from each country are stated in the following table. Maximum numbers of participants from the organizing country are stated in the brackets.

4.6. The top 20 players in the season's overall World Table Hockey Tour ranking directly qualify for the open category of the international championship held in the same season. Also, the top 3 veterans, the top 3 superveterans, the top 3 juniors, the top 3 kids and the top 3 women in the season's overall WTHT ranking directly qualify for the veterans/superveterans/juniors/kids/women categories respectively.

Direct qualification is not transferable to any player in a lower position in the WTHT ranking.

4.7. Players in top 20 in the open category in the ITHF World Ranking at May, 1 are automatically qualified for the annual international championship (World Championships, European Championships) in the open category without having to qualify through a national or international qualification tournament.

4.8. Defending champions in each category can participate (the only exception is the juniors and the kids categories, where the defending champion can participate only if he/she fulfils the age requirement). All former champions in the Open category can participate in the Open category.

4.9. If a player wants a wild card, he/she should apply at his national federation, which could decide to give a place from its national quota to this player.

5. Teams

5.1. Only one national team can represent each country in each team competition. The EC of the ITHF can allow an international team to participate in the team competition, but none of its members can be representatives of a country that is participating in the team competition.

5.2. Each team in the open category consists of five players. The minimum number of team members is four and the maximum is ten.

5.3. Each women team consists of three players. The minimum number of women team members is two and the maximum is five.

5.4. Each veterans team consists of three players. The minimum number of veterans team members is two and the maximum is five.

5.5. Each juniors team consists of three players. The minimum number of juniors team members is two and the maximum is five.

5.6. Substitution of players during team matches is allowed between each 5-minute round. Once a player has been substituted, that player cannot play again in that team match.

5.7. The captain of each team must be announced to the organizers no later than the start of the play-off or placement matches. If the team captain is not indicated before the start of the match, then the player who is indicated in the protocol of the first round on the first table is considered to be the captain. If the team captain was replaced and did not play in the last round, he cannot participate in the captains' match. In this case, the player who played in the last round instead of the specified captain plays in the captains' match.

5.8. The protocol form for the Open Team category is given in Appendix 2.

5.9. The protocol form for other team categories is given in Appendix 3.

6. Seeding

6.1. Participants in the individual tournament have to be seeded by world ranking in the open category, which can be found at the web page <https://stiga.trefik.cz/ithf/ranking/ranking.aspx>. Players of one country should be evenly distributed among different groups. It is allowed to move one or two places relative to the ranking to achieve an even seeding of players from the same country.

6.2. All participants in tournaments must be distributed to the basic groups with respect to their seeding. Each group should be of the same quality with respect to the seeding of the players, thus insuring that each group is equal in competitive strength to all other groups. Each basic group should have the same number of participants, if possible.

6.3. The organizers have to prepare a schedule for the group stages of all competition categories such that players from the same nation meet during the first rounds of the group. This rule must be observed as much as possible.

6.4. If there is more than one group stage, then distribution to groups at these stages will be in accordance with the playing system of the tournament and the results from the previous stage of the competition. Mutual matches of players promoted to the next group stage from the same basic group can be counted in the next group stage if this was written in the description of the tournament's playing system.

6.5. Seeding of teams in team competitions should be done by using the world ranking of the three best members of each team.

7. Schedule

7.1. The schedule for the World and European Championships must be uniform and understandable for all participants in all categories.

7.2. The tournament cannot start earlier than 8:00 and must end before 22:30.

7.3. There should be a lunch break for all participants of at least one hour in duration.

7.4. The day of preparation of hall for the championship. On this day (Thursday), the organizers can register all participants, organize a fourth level tournament or

other events dedicated to the World or European Championships (for example, a general meeting of national delegates or an opening ceremony).

7.5. The first day (Friday). This day, 6 categories of medals are played among veterans, juniors and women, both in team and individual competitions. Three team tournaments are played in the morning. Three individual tournaments are held in the afternoon. A detailed schedule for the first day of tournaments is given in Appendix 4.

7.6. The second day (Saturday). On this day, teams, kids and superveterans play. There is also a qualification in the open category. A detailed schedule for the second day of tournaments is given in Appendix 5.

7.7. The third day (Sunday). Final groups, divisions and play-offs are played in the open category. A detailed schedule for the third day of tournaments is given in Appendix 6.

8. Team tournaments system

8.1. If 2-6 teams participate in the tournament, they play a round in one group. Play-offs for medals from semifinals (*1-4, 2-3*). Other teams play for 5-6 places.

8.2. If 7-8 teams participate in the tournament, they play a round in two groups. Play-offs for medals from semifinals (*A1-B2, B1-A2*). Other teams play for 5th-8th places from the semifinals (*A3-B4, B3-A4*).

8.3. If 9-12 teams participate in the tournament, they play a round in two groups. Play-offs for medals from 1/4 finals (*A1-B4, B2-A3, B1-A4, A2-B3*. *The winners of the first and second pairs, as well as the third and fourth pairs play in the semifinals. The losers in these pairs continue to play for places 5th through 8th*). Other teams play for 9th-12th places from the semifinals (*A5-B6, B5-A6*).

8.4. If 13-24 teams participate in the tournament, they play a round in four groups. Play-offs for medals from 1/4 finals (*A1-D2, C1-B2, B1-C2, D1-A2*. *The winners of the first and second pairs, as well as the third and fourth pairs play in the semifinals. The losers in these pairs continue to play for places 5th through 8th*). The third place teams in the groups play for 9th-12th place from the semifinals (*A3-D3, B3-C3*). Similarly, the teams ranked fourth in the groups play for 13-16th places, etc.

9. Individual tournaments system

9.1. If up to 21 players participate in the tournament, they play one round in one group. The best 8 players at the end of the group stage play in a play-off with 1/4 finals.

1/4 finals:

pair 1: 1 – 8

pair 2: 2 – 7

pair 3: 3 – 6

pair 4: 4 – 5

semifinal:

pair 5: winner of pair 1 – winner of pair 4

pair 6: winner of pair 2 – winner of pair 3

match for 3rd place:

loser of pair 5 – loser of pair 6

final:

winner of pair 5 – winner of pair 6

9.2. If 22 to 42 players participate in the tournament, they are divided into two basic groups (A and B) and play one round in each group. The best 4 players from each group at the end of the group stage play in a play-off with 1/4 finals.

1/4 finals:

pair 1: A1 – B4

pair 2: B1 – A4

pair 3: A2 – B3

pair 4: B2 – A3

semifinal:

pair 5: winner of pair 1 – winner of pair 4

pair 6: winner of pair 2 – winner of pair 3

match for 3rd place:

loser of pair 5 – loser of pair 6

final:

winner of pair 5 – winner of pair 6

9.3. If 43 to 72 players participate in the tournament, they are divided into four basic groups and play one round in each group. The best 6 players from basic groups A and D play in the final division 1A, and the best 6 players from basic groups B and C play in the final division 1B. Players promoted to a final division from the same basic group do not have to play against each other again. Mutual matches in this case will be counted.

Players who take 7-9 places in the basic groups play in division 2. Players who take 10-12 places in the basic groups play in division 3. Players who take 13-15 places in the basic groups play in division 4. Players who take 16-18 places in the basic groups play in division 5. If there are less than 5 players in one of the divisions, then they will play in the division whose number is one less. Players in divisions play without saving the points selected in the basic groups.

The best 4 players from each final division play in a play-off with 1/4 finals.

1/4 finals:

pair 1: 1A1 – 1B4

pair 2: 1B1 – 1A4

pair 3: 1A2 – 1B3

pair 4: 1B2 – 1A3

semifinal:

pair 5: winner of pair 1 – winner of pair 4

pair 6: winner of pair 2 – winner of pair 3

match for 3rd place:

loser of pair 5 – loser of pair 6

final:

winner of pair 5 – winner of pair 6

The best 4 players from each division play in a play-off with semifinal without 3rd place series.

semifinal:

pair 1: 1 – 4

pair 2: 2 – 3

final:

winner of pair 1 – winner of pair 2

9.4. If more than 72 players participate in the tournament, they are divided into eight basic groups and play one round in each group. The best 8 players from basic groups A, D, E and H play in the final division 1A and the best 8 players from base groups B, C, F and G play in the final division 1B. Players promoted to a final division from the same basic group do not have to play against each other again. Mutual matches in this case will be counted.

Players who take 9-11 places in the basic groups play in division 2. Players who take 12-14 places in the basic groups play in division 3. Players who take 15-17 places in the basic groups play in division 4. Players who take 18-20 places in the basic groups play in division 5 etc. If there are less than 5 players in one of the divisions, then they will play in the division whose number is one less. Players in divisions play without saving the points selected in the basic groups.

The best 16 players from each final division play in a play-off with 1/16 finals.

1/16 finals:

The best 4 players from each division play in a play-off with semifinal without 3rd place series.

semifinal:

pair 1: 1 – 4

pair 2: 2 – 3

final:

winner of pair 1 – winner of pair 2

9.5. In the categories Open, Women, Veterans and Juniors at all stages of the play-offs they play in matches to the best-of-7. Bronze match and series in divisions to the best-of-5.

In the categories Superveterans and Kids, all play-off stages must be up to the best-of-5. Bronze matches to the best-of-3.

10. Match in play-off

10.1. The home player is the player ranked higher in the group stage (stage in which standings are used for seeding of the play-off). If the players played in different groups and their positions in these groups were the same, then the tie-breaking system described in the ITHF Tournament Rules are used to decide the order in which the players select games. Several players cannot select the same game. The player who was placed higher in the preceding group (using the tie-breaking system) will select game first, and so on.

10.2. The home player can select the game and where to play and instead opponent may choose the side of the game. The player who chooses the game has to let the opponent choose the side.

10.3. If a game is faulty, the player may modify it so that it behaves normally (e.g. making the ice surface flat). Modifications that make the game behave abnormally (e.g. raising part of the ice to make a ridge that will trap the puck) are prohibited.

10.4. During a match, the only repair allowed is to replace broken figures – the game can only be seriously repaired if both opponents agree. If the players cannot agree on the quality of the selected game, the committee of referees shall decide if there is any need for repair or replacement of the game, any figure or any rod.

10.5. In team competitions:

10.5.1. The home team can choose which of these games they want. The away team can choose the side of each individual game.

10.5.2. Arrangement of players in the first round in the Open Team category (*home team play on side A, away team play on side B*):

A1 – B1

A2 – B2

A3 – B3

A4 – B4

A5 – B5

10.5.3. Arrangement of players in the first round in team categories other than Open Team (*home team play on side A, away team play on side B*):

A1 – B1

A2 – B2

A3 – B3

10.5.4. All players in both teams move one step to the right between games.

10.5.5. Any modifications to games (e.g. rod replacements) can be requested by either team before the match. No further changes to games may be made during the round, except in the event of breakages.

10.5.6. After the captain of the guest team has given a completed team sheet to the captain of the home (opponent) team, the guest team cannot substitute its players until after the next 5-minute match.

10.6. The results of the matches shall be entered into the score sheet in accordance with the requirements of paragraph 4.2 of the Tournament Rules.

10.7. Any participating player can ask the committee of referees for a referee before any of his/her play-off matches. This referee will ensure observance of the table hockey rules and can be asked by either of the opponents to start all face-offs during the match.

11. Responsibilities of the organizers after the tournament

11.1. The awards ceremony must take place after the end of the entire game day. In case the timing is late, the awards ceremony can be held after the end of a particular category. In this case after the awards ceremony, at least 15 minutes must elapse before the next stage of the tournament begins.

11.2. The podium must be large enough to accommodate all participants in the awards ceremony.

11.3. The anthem of the country of the winner of the tournament must be played at the award ceremony.

11.4. All participants should know their results immediately after the tournament. Organizers must send results to the world ranking list administrator within two days after the tournament.

12. Use of other ITHF rules

12.1. The World and European Championships use the ITHF Game Rules.

12.2. The ITHF Tournaments Rules apply to the World and European Championships to the extent that does not contradict these Rules.

12.3. Tournament participants and spectators must abide by the rules set forth in the Code of conduct for players and spectators at competitions held by ITHF. In case of violation of such rules, the Tournament Referee Committee may apply disciplinary sanctions to violators as provided in Section 4 of this Code.

13. Force majeure

13.1. The detailed schedules for the three days of the tournaments, given in Appendices 4, 5 and 6, depending on the number of participants in the tournaments, may be changed by agreement with the ITHF Executive Committee.

13.2. In case of force majeure (war, natural disaster, organisers' refusal to hold the tournament, etc.):

- the World or European Championships may be cancelled;
- the date of the World or European Championships may be postponed;
- the World or European Championships may be moved to another country.

13.3. All of the above actions except cancellation of the tournament are possible as a result of a voting in an ITHF Delegates Conference.

13.4. If at the end of a season the World Championship or the European Championship is not held, then ITHF holds ITHF Masters in which 50 best players following the results of the ITHF World Table Hockey Tour this season can take part. This tournament receives the second level in the ITHF World Ranking.

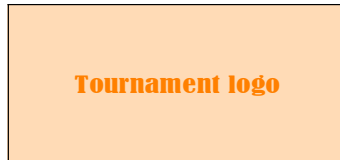
